7. Successful applicants are obligated to obtain their feathers and other items **in person** at the Feather Issuance Ceremony to be held in late May of each year in Saskatoon.
8. Successful applicants are responsible for their travel costs to the Feather Issuance Ceremony.
9. Consistent with Indigenous Nations and ancestral protocols, an offering of tobacco and cloth must be presented at the Feather Issuance Ceremony.
10. At the Feather Issuance Ceremony, the successful applicants will be spoken to by Elders about the responsibilities and appropriate protocols for the handling of feathers and/or talons/bone parts.
