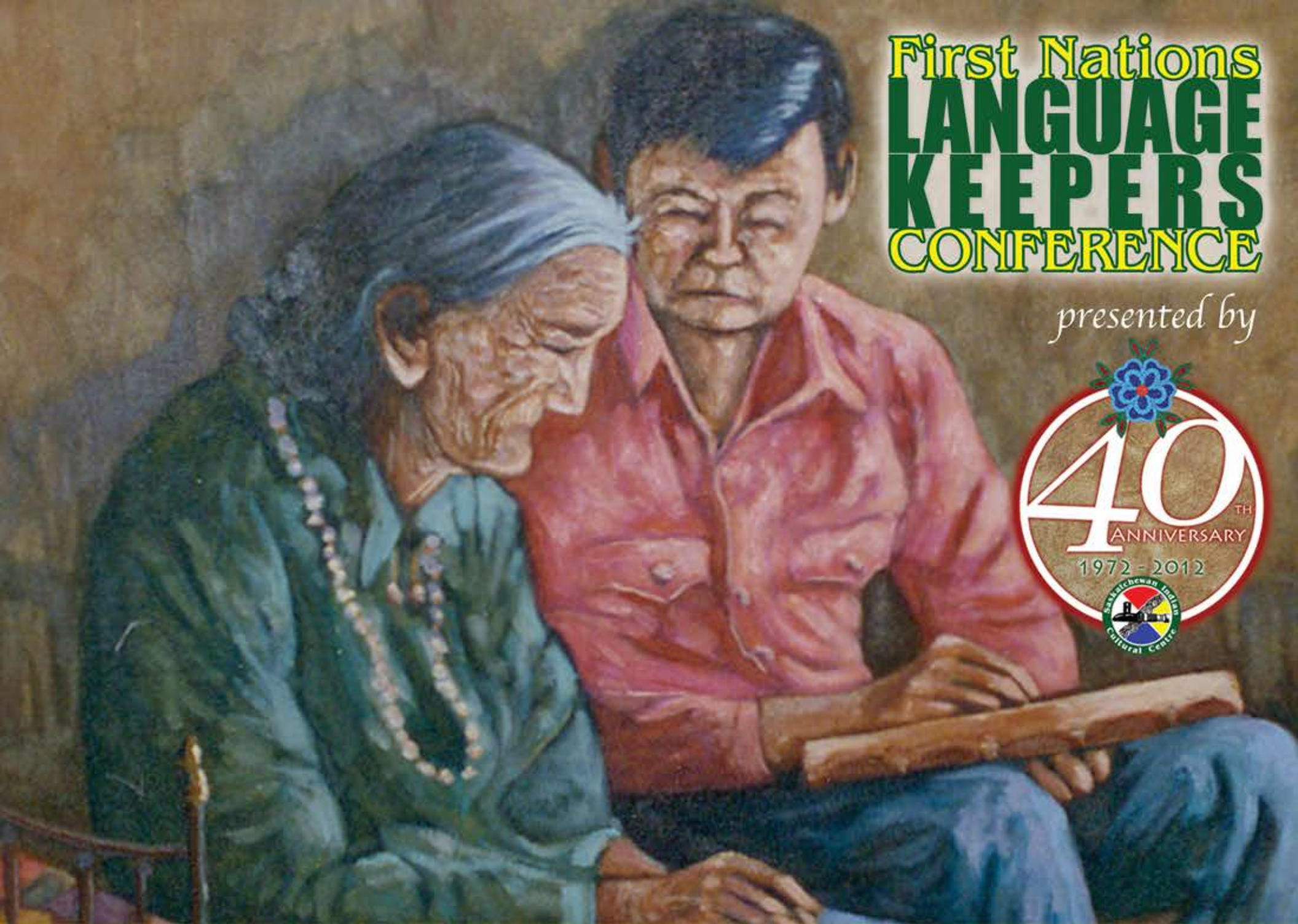


First Nations LANGUAGE KEEPERS CONFERENCE
